

## Middle Ground Prompts

- What we currently learn in school is relevant to students' futures.
- You need an education to have a good future.
- Teachers care about/respect students' voices.
- Teachers at my school build relationships with students.
- The students at my school are *high spirited* = not depressed.
- Mental health is talked about / supported in schools.
- Anti Bullying is supported in my school.
- My school is cultured / schools celebrate the different cultures in school.
- Different religions are supported in my school.
- Different races are treated differently at my school.
- My school is aware of islamophobia.
- The LGBTQ+ community has a support system in my school.
- Students are safe in today's school.
- My school has fair restorative Justice and equitable discipline
- Current textbooks are outdated.
- Phones are a distraction to students learning.
- Teachers try to adapt to students' cultures.
- Teachers understand that students learn differently, and try to cater to that.
- I feel valued as a person in my school.
- High school students need recess.

## How much time per prompt

- 1 minute for the people who agree with the prompt and come to talk in the circle.
- 1 minute for the rest of the people that join the circle / conversation afterwards.
- If no one first agrees with the prompt then everyone comes in to talk about the prompt.
- If time runs out, the conversation must stop.
- If there is an awkward silence / no one is talking we will move onto the next prompt

## Flow

1. Say prompt
2. 30 seconds for "agree" group to come forward and sit
3. 1 minute per person (up to 6 minutes) -- agree and explain why
4. 30 seconds for "disagree" group to come forward and
5. 1 minute per person (up to 6 minutes) -- disagree and explain why
6. 7 - 8 minutes per prompt
7. 6 prompts \* 8 minutes = 48 minutes
